WASAGA BEACH, ONT. (September 4, 2001) D&A Video Systems, a division of Dunphy & Associates Inc, announced today that they have been awarded a 3 year contract with the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) to oversee a \$10 million dollar cell upgrade project. D&A Video was retained as the CCTV Systems Specialist/Consultant for this project, a project that will see 120 OPP Detachments across the Province, identified as priority sites, go through various upgrades in order to comply with the Police Services Act (Adequacy and Effectiveness guidelines), and meet compliance with various Coroner Inquest recommendations.

"It is my understanding that we were chosen for this project on account of our expertise in the field of Video Surveillance," says Steve Dunphy, President of D&A Video. "In the past, the OPP have relied on independent security consultants that had little or no practical experience in this field. They (consultants) were recommending old technology, because they were not familiar with new breakthroughs in CCTV technology, and there was no consistency with equipment from one detachment to the next. The OPP were mandated to bring their facilities and holding cells to a higher standard, and by bringing on a company that specializes in CCTV systems and equipment as their primary business, only made sense," says Dunphy.

The proposed implementation schedule is to have the Central & GTA regions commence in 2002/2003, Eastern & Western regions in 2003/2004, and North East & North West regions being completed in 2004/2005.
